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Consideration should be made for face shape when selecting a patient's veneer style. Most faces fall into four major categories: heart, oval, round, and square. Each face shape has an optimal tooth size and shape to balance its features.

- Heart Shape:** Complimented by smile designs that include rounded and shorter features.
- Oval Shape:** Designs with square teeth are recommended, helping to widen and add fullness to the face.
- Round Shape:** Rounded faces are often enhanced by longer and more pronounced designs.
- Square Shape:** Defined jaw lines and square facial features can be softened and balanced with rounded designs.

Smile Design Descriptions

- Youthful** Round shape with longer canines
- Vigorous** Square shaped teeth with sharp and prominent canines.
- Softened** Rounded teeth with a more discrete curvature.
- Oval** Round shape with rounded canines and incisors.
- Natural** Slightly rounded shape with very pointed canines.
- Mature** Square shaped teeth with slightly rounded canines.
- Hollywood** Square shaped with slightly shorter lateral incisors. This is one of the most popular veneer styles and typically preferred for male patients.
- Functional** Slightly rounded shape with pointed canines for optimal function.
- Focused** Slightly rounded teeth with square central incisors.
- Enhanced** Slightly rounded with a more discrete curvature.
- Dominant** Square shaped teeth with more prominent front teeth and rounded canines.
- Aggressive** Square shaped, uniform teeth for a bold impression. Typically more common for males.
